1. Petitioner filed the instant petition u/s 9 of The Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking interim relief in the nature of appointment of receiver with direction to take possession of security/vehicle bearing Registration No.UP 16MT 4096 hypothecated with petitioner.
2. Along with the petition, petitioner filed an application seeking ad-interim relief in the nature of *ex parte* appointment of receiver with a direction to take possession of the subject property.
3. The application filed by petitioner along with the petition was allowed on 25.02.2026. Receiver was appointed to take possession of the vehicle.
4. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the vehicle in question is not traceable and same could not be repossessed despite sincere efforts made by the receiver. He further submits that petitioner has already initiated the process of appointment of Arbitrator in terms of arbitration clause of the agreement executed between the parties. He prays to dispose off the petition.
5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts into account and the request made by learned counsel for petitioner, the instant petition filed by petitioner is disposed off.
