The counsel for the complainant has submitted that in compliance of Section 156(3) of Cr.P.C., he has given a complaint to the Police Sub-Inspector and S.P. on 16.03.2023 and 17.03.2023 respectively, however, no action has been taken on his complaint and hence, complainant has filed affidavit along with copy of the complaint given to the Police Sub-Inspector and S.P. in compliance with Section 156(3) of Cr.P.C, and also in compliance with the decision *Priyanka Srivastava & another vs. State of U.P. & others* reported in *(2015) 6 SCC 287*.
