

The plaintiff has filed the present suit for Parmanent Injunction of the suit schedule property against the defendant. The present application U/o 39 Rule 1 & 2 of CPC sought to pass an ex-parte order of temporary injunction restraining the defendant not to interfere with the plaintiff lawful and peaceful possession and enjoyment over the suit schedule property till disposal of the suit.

Heard, and perused the documents. The plaintiff has made out a prima-facie case at this stage. If notice is issued at the first instance, the very purpose of granting injunction would be defeated by delay. Hence, defendant is restrained from not to interfere with the plaintiff lawful and peaceful possession and enjoyment over the suit schedule properties till next date of hearing.

Issue temporary injunction accordingly, the plaintiff is directed to comply with the provision of order 39 Rule 3 of C.P.C.

Office is directed not to issue certified copy of this order till compliance is made.

Issue suit summons and ex-parte temporary injunction order to defendant, if sufficient PF is paid.
