ORDER

Applicant has moved this application under section 503 of BNSS for releasing of seized amount in respect to online complaint acknowledgement no. 31204240001857 from the account of fraudster. It is averred in the application that the applicant is victim of financial fraud to the tune of Rs.99,500/-. The matter was reported to police station Gaggal. In the intervention of cyber crime police station Dharamshala, the money of Rs.8000/- has been freezed, which requires approval from this court before it can be released to the applicant. Once the approval is obtained, the applicant will be able to receive the frozen amount. Hence the present application for release of said amount.

2. Report of the police called. Police has raised no objection on release of the aforesaid amount to owner/ complainant.

3. Heard. Record perused. Reportedly the applicant/ complainant is the owner of the amount of Rs 8000/- which has been freezed by the cyber cell. As per report of P.S Gaggal, the account in which the alleged amount has been transferred stands freezed and the account holder has not come for defreezing the accounts in question in which the amount is alleged to have fraudulently transferred. Therefore, this court is of the opinion that interest of justice will serve if aforesaid amount is ordered to be released to the applicant on Indemnity Bond of Rs.8000/- subject to the following conditions:

(i) That the applicant/ complainant shall produce the aforesaid amount as and when required either by the police or by the court

2) that the applicant shall furnish indemnity bond in the aforesaid sum, in case said amount is claimed by the other person in whose account said amount has been debited.

4. Indemnity bond as directed furnished, attested and accepted by me. **Aforesaid amount of Rs.8,000/- be released or deposited back in account of the complainant bearing No.922010031842318 IFSC Code UTIB0005528 from the account numbers as mentioned in the report filed by the police**, if not required in any other case after defreezing the account of alleged accused. Release order be prepared

accordingly. Application stands disposed of. These papers after due completion be tagged with the main case FIR.
