Plaintiff and the defendants and their counsels are present. Negotiations are held between the parties. Parties agreed for the settlement and filed the joint compromise petition U/o 23 Rule 3 of CPC and pray to dispose off the suit in view of the joint compromise petition.

Parties have filed joint compromise petition stating that they have compromised the matter before the elders of their family. The petition is duly signed by all the plaintiff and defendants. The parties are identified by their respective counsels. There are no minors in the present suit. Contents of the compromise petition have been read over to the parties in their known language. They have understood contents of the same. This court is of the opinion that parties have compromised the matter on their own volition.

There are no factual and legal impediment to accept the compromise.

Accordingly the following order.

**ORDER**

The joint compromise petition filed U/o 23 Rule 3 of CPC is hereby allowed and it is accepted accordingly.

Draw final decree interms of joint compromise petition. The joint compromise petition treated as part and parcel of decree.
