- 1) Whether the plaintiffs prove that the suit schedule properties are joint family properties of themselves and defendants 1 to 4?
- 2) Whether defendant No.5 and 6 prove that defendant No.5 is a bonafide purchaser of survey number 217/0 measuring 1 acre 12 gunta of Kunduru village?
- 3) Whether defendant No.5, 6 and 7 prove that this Sy. No. 217/0 was the self acquired property of defendant No.4 as per the gift deed dated: 08.09.2017 executed by defendant No.1?
- 4) Whether defendant No.10 proves that Sy. No. 151/3, 190/2, 191/2B, item No.11 house property are the self acquired properties of Lohitheshwarappa and that Sy. NO. 110/1 was jointly purchased by Lohitheswarappa and Veerabasappa?
- 5) Whether defendant No.10 proves that Lohitheshwarappa on 19.01.2022 duly executed a Will in his favor in respect of Sy. No. 190/2 and Sy. No. 218/P2 and executed a Will in favor of Nikhil S/o Manjunatha M.L. in respect of Sy. No. 151/3, 191/2B, 110/1?

- 6) Whether the suit is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties and non-inclusion of all the joint family properties?
- 7) Whether defendant No.8 and 9 are entitled for the relief of partition and separate possession prayed by them as prayed in the counter claim?
- 8) Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to 1/4th share or any share in the suit schedule properties?
- 9) Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the relief of partition and separate possession as prayed for?
- 10) Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the reliefs prayed for?
- 11) What order or decree?
