ORDER ON THE BAIL APPLICATION FILED BY THE ACCUSED

1. This is an application filed by the accused AKASH JALINDER VINKAR @ SONU for granting bail. According to him, he is alleged to have committed an offences punishable under sections 319 (2), 318 (4), 316(2) r/w.s. 3(5) of The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. It is contended that, he has not committed any offence, as alleged. He is resident of Kajupada, Borivali, Mumbai. Lastly, he prayed for bail.
2. Investigating Officer and Ld. A.P.P. Shri Joshi for the State resisted the application and contented that, the offence is cognizable in nature and non-bailable. The accused cheated the informant and fraudulently withdrawn an amount of ₹.3,00,000/- by committed forgery of cheques. It is further contended that, the accused persons have falsely represented the informant about loan amount of ₹.35,00,000/- at the lowest rate of 9% p.a. and they have received cheques from informant for process fee and committed the forgery of cheques and withdrawn an amount of ₹.3,00,000/- from the account of informant. If accused released on bail he would tamper the prosecution witnesses. The investigation is yet to be completed. Lastly, they prayed for rejection of bail.
3. Heard Ld. Advocate Shri Igve for accused and Ld. A.P.P. Shri Joshi for the State.
4. Perused the record. The F.I.R. bearing No.970/2025 dated 17/09/2025, came to be registered as per information given by informant to police station Santacruz. It is alleged that, accused falsely represented about the loan facility and induced him to deliver the cheques to them and they have forging the said cheque withdrawn the

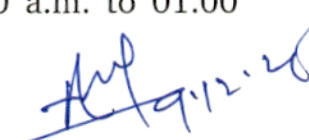
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amount of ₹.3,00,000/- from the bank account of informant. The particular role of the present accused is that he has collected the cheques from the informant for commission. It is to be noted that, during PCR period nothing has been recovered from accused. The accused arrested on 02/12/2025 and remanded to PCR and on 06/12/2025 he has been remanded to judicial custody.

5. Accused is resident of Borivali, Mumbai. The investigation for which custody required has been completed. The offence against accused is triable by this court and not punishable with death penalty of imprisonment for life. Further, the presence of accused can be secured through surety, his further detention is not at all required by imposing conditions accused can be released on bail. Further, other accused by name Dilip Chauhan and Jigar Kareliya also released on bail, therefore, I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

- 1 Application is allowed.
- 2 The accused be released on P. R. and S. B. of ₹.15,000/-.
- 3 The accused shall not tamper with prosecution witness and evidence.
- 4 The accused shall provisionally be released on cash bail of ₹.15,000/- and he shall furnish surety within four weeks.
- 5 The accused shall produce on record copies of documents showing his permanent address.
- 6 The accused shall remain present before Investigating Officer on each second and fourth Saturday of each month till filing the chargesheet at around 11.00 a.m. to 01.00 p.m.
