- 4) Whether defendant No.3 proves that already a partition has taken place in the year 1994 in respect of the ancestral properties?
- 5) Whether defendant No.3 proves that the suit is not maintainable in view of the compromise decree passed in OS No. 27/2016?
- 6) Whether defendant No.3 proves that item No.7 property of the suit schedule had come to defendant No.1 and 2 under a Will and later in a partition it is allotted to her?
- 7) Whether plaintiffs are entitled to 1/4th share each or any share in the suit schedule properties?

- 8) Whether plaintiffs are entitled for the relief of partition and separate possession as prayed for?
- 9) Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the reliefs prayed for?
- 10) To what order or decree?
