

MHPA020007872026 	<u>ORDER BELOW EXH.01</u>
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The present application is filed for grant of heirship certificate under section 2 of Bombay Regulation No. VIII of 1827.

2] I have carefully perused the application and heard learned advocate Mohd. Mazher for the applicants. Learned advocate for applicants submitted that, applicant No.1 is wife and applicant No.2 is son of deceased **Anna Gangaram Thakur** who died on 18.03.2026 at residential house at Yelarkar Colony, Vasmat Road, Parbhani, Tq. & District Parbhani. Applicants require heirship certificate for the purpose of legal recognition and for fulfilling legal formalities of local Government and Semi-Government office. Therefore, they have approached to the Court and prayed for issuance of same.

3] As per order below Exhibit 1 paper proclamation was directed. After proclamation of notice in daily news paper "**Dainik Deshonnati**" dated 12.06.2026 at Exh.10, objections were invited. However, no one has appeared before the court and raised any objection for issuance of heirship certificate in the name of applicants. Therefore, no one is added as respondent.

4] In support of the claim, applicant No.2 has filed evidence affidavit at Exhibit 11 and reproduced the contents of the main application. On oath he has stated that, there are no other legal heirs to

the deceased except these applicants. To support the claim, applicants have produced on record verified copy of death certificate of deceased **Anna Gangaram Thakur** issued by Parbhani city Municipal Corporation, Parbhani at Exh.12, verified copy of Aadhar card of deceased and applicants at Exh. 13 to 15. Lastly, applicants have filed evidence close pursis at Exh.16 and closed their evidence.

5] Thus, on perusal of record it appears that, in spite of paper proclamation, no one has appeared and raised any objection for issuance of legal heirship certificate in favour of applicants. There is no reason to disbelieve on evidence affidavit and documents filed on record. The applicants being wife and son of deceased **Anna Gangaram Thakur** come under class I legal heirs of the deceased according to Hindu Succession Act, 1956. Therefore, the application deserves to be allowed. Hence, the following order is passed.

ORDER

1.	The application (Exh.1) is allowed.
2.	Issue legal heirship certificate in the name of applicants formally recognizing them as legal heirs of the deceased namely Anna Gangaram Thakur on payment of requisite court fees.
