

Case is called out before Lok Adalath.

The petitioner and his counsel are present. Respondent is also present. The parties are intending to settle the matter before Lok-adalath. Accordingly, the matter is conciliated.

Both the parties have filed joint memo stating that the respondent has consented to enter the date of birth of the petitioner's daughter in the Birth and death register and issue birth certificate subject to condition that, if any dispute regarding date of Birth, it is not conclusive proof.

The petitioner and his counsel as well as respondent signed the joint memo. Perused the joint memo and documents produced by the petitioner. On perusal of the same it reveals that there is no entry of date of birth of petitioner's daughter in the Birth and Death register. As per the joint memo the respondent consented to make necessary entry in the concerned register, subject to condition that, if any dispute regarding date of Birth, it is not

conclusive proof. Therefore, I proceed to pass the following:

:ORDER :

The respondent is hereby directed to enter the Date of Birth of **Petitioner's daughter by name Nashath B S D/o Mohamed Abdul Bari K and Mother Tabraz Unnisa was born on 21.05.1988 at Sasvehalli village, Honnali Taluk.** In the concerned register and issue Birth Certificate in-favour of the petitioner, subject to condition that if any dispute arise regarding date of Birth, it is not conclusive proof.
