1. The present application has been filed by the applicants seeking Legal Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation Act (VIII) of 1827 read with Para 304 of the Civil Manual and Indian Succession Act, 1925.

2. According to the applicants, Gulab Khan s/o Jafar Khan Pathan died on 05.02.1993 at Parbhani. He was permanent resident of Parbhani. Applicant No.1 to 3 and respondent No.2 are sons of the deceased. Respondent No.1 is died son, respondent No.1/1 is daughter-in-law, and respondent Nos.1/2 to 1/8 are grandsons and granddaughters of deceased Gulab Khan. The applicants and the respondents are the only legal heirs of the deceased. Except them, there are no heirs to the deceased. For legal recognition and availing benefits of the Government schemes the applicants required legal heirship certificate. Accordingly, this application moved by them for issuance of legal heirship certificate in their name including the respondents.

3. The respondents were served with notice of this application, but they failed to appear, therefore, this application is proceeded ex-parte against them.
