

**ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN Cri.M.A.No.28/2024**

(CNR NO.MHSN170026352020)

(Bhanudas Bhimrao Suryawanshi Vs. State of Maharashtra)

1. This is an application for relaxation of bail condition in respect of attendance to the police station. The State has failed to file its say. Read the application. Perused the record.

2. Undisputedly, the applicants were granted bail with condition to attend the police station on every Monday and Thursday till further order.. The order was passed on 04.08.2023. Now, Hon'ble Bombay High Court while passing order dt. 06.03.2023 in Writ Petition No.3365 of 2023 observed that in view of the investigation and the evidence collected during the investigation, names of the applicants are deleted from the charge-sheet on account of lack of evidence and proof of their absence from the spot of the incident and therefore, said writ petition for quashing of C.R.No.394/2023 registered with Vita Police station has been disposed of. In view of above observation, relaxation of condition does not survive and it is liable to be disposed of. Accordingly, I pass the following order :-

**ORDER**

1. Cri.M.A.No.28/2024 is disposed of as the names of applicants are deleted from the charge-sheet.
3. Cri.M.A. is disposed of.
