Witness SI Sanjay is present for deposing as the MHC(M) at the relevant date. However, the Id. Prosecutor submits that in view of the lengthy proceedings recorded in register no. 19 brought by him today, the assistance of the IO is required for deciphering the same. It is further stated that the IO is already summoned for the next date which is tomorrow i.e. 31.08.2024.
