

ORDERS ON IA No.I

Perused the plaint averments, documents, IA No.I, the affidavit filed by the plaintiff in support of IA No.I.

I.A.No.I is filed by the plaintiff under Order XXXIX Rule 1 and 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure seeking an order to restrain the defendant from alienating the suit schedule property by way of sale, partition, relinquishment deed, family settlement, gift, lease, mortgage in any manner, till pending disposal of the suit.

This suit is filed by the plaintiff against the defendant for the relief of Specific performance and permanent injunction. On perusal of the pleadings and documents produced by the plaintiff, it appears that at this stage the reasons assigned in the affidavit are satisfactory. Hence, at this stage, the delay in issuance of notice will defeat the purpose of the order of Temporary Injunction. Therefore, this Court proceeds to pass the following :

ORDERS

Issue exparte ad-interim temporary injunction restraining the defendant from alienating the suit schedule property to anybody by way of sale, partition, relinquishment deed, family settlement, gift, lease,

mortgage or in any manner.

The above order shall be in force till filing of the objections.

The plaintiff shall comply the Order 39 Rule 3(a) and (b) of CPC.

The office is hereby directed not to issue certified copy of this order until the requisite P.F. is paid.

ORDERS

Issue exparte ad-interim temporary injunction restraining the defendant and his agents, servants and relatives or anybody acting on behalf of him from interfering with peaceful possession plaintiff over the suit schedule property.

The above order shall be in force till filing of the objections.

The plaintiff shall comply the Order 39 Rule 3(a) and (b) of CPC.
