Examination in Chief by Public Prosecutor :-

1. From 2013 to November, 2016, I had worked as ASI in Surathkal P.S.

2. On the intervening night of 08/09.02.2014, I was SHO of Surathkal P.S. At 22:00, CW.43 HC-918, Janardhan Gowda came to police station and handed over written complaint before me. On verification of complaint, the same was lodged by Gurudas mother of Sumathi Prabhu on the spot. The said complaint was received by CW.42 and sent the same through CW.43. After going through the complaint, I registered case in Crime No.44/2014. I now see complaint Ex.P1, it bears my an endorsement and signature. Signature of witness is marked as Ex.P1(b). At 22:45, I sent an FIR to Jurisdictional Court through CW.34 and to my higher officials.

I now see an FIR, it bears my signature. The same are marked as Ex.P25 and 25(a). I sent copy of FIR and complaint to P.I. through CW.43.

Cross-examination by Sri. RKA Advocate for accused No.1:-

3. It is false to suggest that I did not receive the complaint at 22:00 on 08.02.2014. It is false to suggest that I did not register FIR at the time mentioned in the FIR. In the complaint assailants names are not forthcoming. In the complaint a suspicion was made against person came in motorcycle. In the complaint there is no suspicion against tenants of the house.
