ORDER:

1. Present bail application u/s 438 Cr.P.C has moved by accused persons/applicant Narinder Singh on the ground that he is falsely implicated in the present case.
2. As per the prosecution version, on 18.09.2021, ASI Hardeep Singh alongwith other police officials in connection with patrolling and checking of suspected persons were going through Garcha Road, Barnala towards Simmi Palace Handiaya road, Barnala side, when the police party ahead of Garcha road, Barnala to Grewal Palace at about 50 feet then it was about 7:45 PM and the right side of the street light one young person was standing seen who on seeing the police party go towards the newly constructed colony. On the basis of suspicion, IO apprehended the accused with help of other police officials. On

query by IO, apprehended person disclosed his name as Harshvir Singh alias Harsh. Then IO conducted personal search of accused and from his possession 38 gram Opium was recovered. During the investigation of the case and interrogation of above said accused, name of Narinder Singh alias Goldy present accused/applicant was cropped up and he was nominated as an accused in the present case to have involved in the drug trafficking. During the investigation of present case, Harshvir Singh accused/non-applicant has admitted that he has brought the opium from present accused/applicant at lower price and sell the same to the customers at high rate and offence 29 of NDPS Act was added upon. Then further investigation in the present matter is carried out.

3 This application for bail u/s 438 Cr.P.C., is filed that accused/applicant is innocent and he has not committed any offence and false case has been registered against him.

4 This Court has heard the learned counsel for accused/applicant and learned Addl. PP for the State and perused the record.

5 That vide order dated 30.09.2021 accused/applicant was granted the interim bail. Today ASI Hardeep Singh No. 283/GRP has come present in the Court and suffered a separate statement that accused/applicant Narinder Singh joined the investigation on 02.10.2021 and he has cooperated in carrying out the investigation in the present case and his custodial interrogation is no more required for further investigation. Thus, in these circumstances since the custodial interrogation of the accused/applicant is no more required, interim bail granted vide order dated 30.09.2021 is hereby made absolute as per the following conditions:

1.That the applicant/accused person shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court;

2.That the applicant/accused person shall not leave India without the permission of the court;

3.That the applicant/accused person shall co operative in the investigation;
