The Case record is put up today being advanced by Id.counsel for the accused. Accused Balaram Nahak is present and files hazira. Advocate Sri Krushna Pradhan and his associates files Vakalatnama for the accused Balaram Nahak. The Vakalatnama is accepted. At this stage Id. Counsel for the accused files a memo stating therein to confess his guilt. Copy served on Id. APP. Heard. Perused the case record and upon perusal of the record, it is found that the case is at the stage of appearance of the accused and at this stage on the substance of accusation being read over and explained, the accused pleaded guilty for the commission of offence punishable U/s.281BNS/194-C/194-D/181 of M.V Act. He is explained about the consequence of pleading guilty but he stills wanted to plead guilty of the commission of the offences. The plea of the guilty appears to be voluntary and thereafter his statement to that effect is recorded vide separate sheets and the same is attached herewith with the case record. On his admission this court holds him guilty for the commission of the offences punishable U/s.281BNS/194-C/194-D/181 of M.V Act and convicted him thereunder.

Since, the commission of such offences is against the state and public at large. Hence, considering the facts and circumstances of this case, keeping in view of greater interest of the society and larger interest of the state, this court is not inclined to extend any of the beneficial provisions laid down under the Probation of Offenders Act to the convict. However, the convict has stated that he wants to reform himself and that he will not repeat such type of offences in the future. Therefore, Considering the age, character and antecedent of the convict, facts and circumstances of the case and nature of allegation, the convict is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.500/- for commission of offence punishable u/s.281BNS, in default on payment of such fine by convict, he shall further undergo simple Imprisonment for one (01) day, to pay fine of Rs-1000/- **for commission of offence u/s.194-C M.V Act**", in default on payment of such fine by convict, he shall further undergo simple Imprisonment for one (01) day, to pay fine of Rs-1000/- **for commission of offence u/s.194-D M.V Act**", in default on payment of such fine by convict, he shall further undergo simple Imprisonment for one (01) day and to pay fine of Rs-5000/- for commission of offence u/s.181 MV Act, in default he shall further undergo simple imprisonment for one (10) days.

The seized **Honda Shine M/C** vehicle bearing Registration number **OD-07G-2354** be released in my favour of the rightful owner after proper verification on production of receipt of payment of fine.
