Business : Counsel for D.Hr prays time to take further steps. Perusal of ordersheet discloses that, D.Hr has not taken proper steps. It appears that, D.Hr is not having sufficient information to pursue the matter. The Honble Supreme Court in its recent decision in the case of Periyammal (Dead) through LRs and others V/s. V. Rajamani and another ETC reported in 2025 INSC 329 has prescribed an outer time limit of 6 months for disposing execution petition and executing court is bound to furnish reasons to the Honble High Court for non compliance of the said time frame, every month. Hence, petition stands dismissed for non prosecution with liberty to file fresh petition. Office is directed to return documents if D.Hr/C files necessary application.
