This order of mine shall dispose of the bail application filed by applicant/accused Tejwant Singh @ Teji son of Baljit Singh resident of Village Birkalan, Tehsil Sunam, District Sangrur.

Notice of the bail application was issued to State and Investigating Officer was called alongwith record. ASI Nek Singh No.381/Sgr. appeared and submitted that he came alongwith record of bail pertaining to the above stated case and in FIR no. 36 dated 22.03.2026 under Section 61/1/14 Excise Act. In the present case 24 bottles of illicit liquor were recovered from accused Tejwant Singh @ Teji. Date of arrest of accused Tejwant Singh @ Teji is 22.03.2026. Till date, there was no bail applied by the accused and no application of his bail is pending or dismissed by any Hon'ble Court.

Learned defence counsel argued that applicant/accused is innocent and false case has been planted upon accused. He was arrested on 22.03.2026 and since then the accused is in custody. He argued that presentation of challan will take time and as such, accused be granted the concession of bail.

I have perused the record. Applicant/accused was arrested on 22.03.2026. Alleged recovery of 24 bottles of illicit liquor has already been effected from the accused. Accused is already in judicial custody. This is the first bail application of applicant/accused. Presentation of challan and conclusion thereof shall take sufficient long time. No useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused behind bars. Moreover, keeping the accused in jail will be a burden on the State Exchequer. Accordingly, the bail application of accused is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.30,000/-with one surety in the like amount, subject to the following conditions:-

1. That applicant/accused shall appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing.
2. The applicant/accused shall not leave India without prior approval of this Court.
3. The applicant/accused shall not tamper with the evidence and shall not threat, induce etc. the witness of prosecution.

4. The applicant/accused shall not commit any similar offence in future.

Bail bonds/surety bonds furnished which are accepted and attested. Release warrants of accused be issued immediately. Papers be attached with the main case file/remand papers.
