ORDER:

This order will decide this application u/s 438 Cr.P.C

2 That present bail application has been filed on the ground that present accused/applicant was unable to appear before the Trial Court on 26.04.2019 and his presence was exempted by the Trial Court on that day and Trial Court adjourned the case to 15.6.2019. But clerk of counsel has noted down the wrong date as 04.08.2019. Due to that reason accused/applicant could not appear before the Trial Court on the date fixed and ultimately he was declared Proclaimed Offender on 17.02.2020. Hence, this application.

3 Notice of this bail application was given to APP for the State
and file of Ld. Lower Court requisitioned.

4 This Court has heard the learned counsel for
accused/applicant and Ld. APP for the State.

5 Perusal of the Trial Court file shows that in present matter
Hon'ble High Court has granted anticipatory bail vide order dt.
18.9.2018. That in pursuance of the order passed by Hon'ble High Court,
Ld. Lower/Trial Court granted the bail vide order dt. 19.11.2018. As
accused become absent on 15.6.2019. That Ld. Trial Court vide order dt.
15.06.2019 only cancelled the bail bonds and surety bonds of the
accused/applicant. This fact shows that bail order dt. 19.11.2018 is still in
existence. It is another matter he has been declared Proclaimed Offender
subsequently.

6 Thus, in view of the above discussion this bail application
stands disposed of being allowed. That accused/applicant is directed to
furnish the fresh bail bonds and surety bonds in the sum of Rs. 25,000/-
with one surety within 15 days from today before Trial Court/Duty
Magistrate.

Trial court file along with copy of this order be sent back.

Bail application file be consigned to the Record Room, Barnala.
