

‘Harman Singh @ Harmandeep Singh vs State of Punjab’

FIR No.71 dated 29.03.2019

By means of his application under consideration, accused-applicant has come up with a prayer for concession of anticipatory bail in respect of case FIR No.71/2019 registered by Police of Police station City Tarn Taran for the commission of offence punishable Under Section 306/506/34 IPC.

Upon notice of the application records of the case have been produced before me which I have perused carefully. I have also heard Learned Addl.PP for the State and the learned counsel for accused at length.

As it becomes clear from the records, FIR in this case was registered by one Gurpreet Singh son of Kulwant Singh, according to got whose version, his niece Kiranpreet Kaur was brought up by him due to the death of his brother about 10 years ago and his wife having left her while she was an infant. Further referring to trangle between his said niece and one Hardeep Singh son of Iqbal Singh and present accused, he contended that his niece Kiranpreet Kaur was married to Hardeep Singh about six months ago regarding which Harman Singh @ Harmandeep Singh, his mother Kawaljit Kaur and sister Kirandeep Kaur used to pressurize them as to why they had married Kiranpreet Kaur with Hardeep Singh instead of Harman Singh @ Harmandeep Singh present accused-applicant and because of this reason, Kiranpreet Kaur allegedly committed suicide and thus he attributed the acts of abettment of suicide on the part of present accused-applicant along with his mother and sister. The death of Kiranpreet Kaur in this case is claimed to have taken place on 29.03.2019 and as per the notarized attested passport copy of accused Harman Singh @ Harmandeep Singh, he had departed from Amritsar Airport on 02.03.2019 and landed in UAE on the same day and has thereafter returned to India on 09.01.2020.

Keeping in view all these facts and circumstances of the case but without commenting upon the merits of the case, accused-applicant Singh is directed to join investigation within a period of 07 days from today and in the

event of his doing so, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of investigating/arresting officer.

For further proceedings to ensure the compliance with this order by the accused-applicant, bail application stands adjourned to 14.02.2020.
