ORDER

This order shall dispose of bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C., filed by applicant Malkeet Singh, in case FIR No.nil dated nil, under Section nil, Police Station Sadar Faridkot.

2. Notice of the bail application was issued to the State and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State appeared and contested the same. Report from Police Station Sadar Faridkot was called and received.

3. I have heard Sh.P.L.Chaudhary, Advocate, learned counsel for applicant and Sh.Amit Goklaney, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, and have carefully gone through the record of case.

4. Learned counsel for applicant has argued that applicant is peace loving and law abiding citizen and permanent resident of village Bhoepur, Tehsil Dharamkot, District Moga. He is quite innocent and is being falsely implicated by the police of Police Station Sadar Faridkot. It is learnt that a false complaint has been filed by complainant party, against Mukhtiar Singh of village Kot Ise Khan and Zilmil Singh of village Gill, at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, for committing offence of cheating. The police is investigating the matter, but no case has been registered so far. Accused-applicant has nothing to do with the alleged offence and even not known either to the complainant or to the other persons named as accused and never met them at any point of time. Under some political pressure, police is harassing and humiliating the accused-applicant and calling him in the Police Station and made to sit there for whole of the day and thereafter to leave the Police Station with promise to come again. He further argued that applicant undertakes to join investigation as and when required by the police or as and when ordered by the Court. It is prayed that applicant may kindly be granted anticipatory bail.

5. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State has opposed the bail application and contended that on the application moved by complainant, enquiry is pending with the police, but

no FIR has been registered against applicant, so, applicant is not entitled to blanket bail and prayed that application be dismissed.

6. I have given my thoughtful consideration to the rival contentions of learned counsel for applicant and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

7. As per report of SHO, Police Station Sadar Faridkot, applicant Malkeet Singh is known with two names. He is also known as Gurmeet Singh Meetu. Said fact has been admitted by wife of applicant and Sarpanch of the village namely Jarnail Kaur, that in the Aadhaar Card and Voter list name of applicant is Malkeet Singh, but in the village he is known as Gurmeet Singh Meetu. FIR No.24 dated 19.2.2020, under Section 21 of NDPS Act, Police Station Dharamkot, has been registered against Malkeet Singh @ Meeta @ Gurmeet Singh and FIR No.115 dated 16.7.2013, under Sections 420,120-B,170,171 IPC and 25 of Arms act, has been registered at Police Station Dharamkot, against Gurmeet Singh son of Kirpal Singh and Mukhtiar Singh etc. FIR No.62 dated 13.4.2015, under Sections 307,452,148,149 IPC and 25,27 of Arms Act, has been registered against Gurmeet Singh son of Kirpal Singh. Application bearing No.1295 PC-7-20 dated 23.11.2020 has been filed by Kulwinder Kumar and Natha Singh against Gurmeet Singh @ Meetu son of Kirpal Singh, Mukhtiar Singh, Jhirmil Singh, ASI Kulwinder Singh and Gurmel Singh @ Geli, as Malkeet Singh @ Gurmeet Singh @ Meetu in connivance with other accused, has cheated them for Rs.Five Lacs on the pretext of doubling the amount. Said application is pending for enquiry,

but no FIR has been registered against applicant. Thus, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, at this stage, no ground for blanket pre-arrest bail is made out. Bail application is accordingly, dismissed. File be consigned to record room.
