ISSUES

1. Whether the plaintiffs prove that, the suit schedule properties are undivided ancestral/joint undivided family properties and they are in joint and constructive possession of 'B' to 'F' schedule properties as described in plaint paras ?
2. Whether the plaintiffs further prove that, the defendants no.6, 12 and 13 colluding together have created false documents as asserted in the plaint ?
3. Whether the defendant no.1 proves that, all the brothers have given Power of Attorney in his favour to transact the loan in the bank and for different arrangements as contended in written statement?
4. Whether the defendant no.1 further proves the agreement for sale dated 03-05-2012 in respect of 'B' and 'C' schedule properties to one Raghavendra as contended in written statement?
5. Whether the defendant no.1 & 10 prove that, the Raghavendra is in possession of 'B' and 'C' schedule properties as contended in written statement?
6. Whether the defendant no.1 & 10 further prove that, the defendant no.1 is in exclusive possession of item no.1 and 2 of 'F' schedule properties as its absolute owner as contended in written statement?
7. Whether the defendant no.1 & 10 prove that, the suit is bad for non joinder of necessary parties as contended in their written statement?

8. Whether the defendant no.10 is entitled for equal 8 share in the properties D, E and item no.3, 4 and 0.79 acres in Sy.No.190/4A, 253/1 and 254/1A1 of 'F' Schedule properties as prayed ?
9. Whether the defendant no.6, 12 and 13 are entitled for equal share as prayed ?
10. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the reliefs as sought for?
11. What order or decree?
