ORDER

Present bail application has been filed by
accused/applicant Harpreet Kumar @ Lovely son of Balwinder
Kumar seeking regular bail under Section 483 of BNSS. Shindo who
is stated to be mother of accused/applicant has also filed her affidavit
that this is the first bail application filed on behalf of
accused/applicant under section 483 of BNSS. As per report of
Ahlmad, no other bail application of accused/applicant is pending in
this FIR.

2. Upon notice, learned APP for the State put in appearance on behalf of the State and contested the bail application. Police record has also been requisitioned. ASI Kuldeep Singh, no.300/Gurdaspur, P.S. Bhaini Mian Khan has appeared along with record and stated that no other bail application of accused/applicant is pending in this FIR in any Court and total recovery in this case is 06 gram heroin.

3. Learned counsel for accused/applicant submitted that he is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case and that alleged recovery is planted one. He further submitted that accused/applicant is in judicial custody since 11.02.2026. Therefore, he prayed that accused/applicant be granted concession of bail.

4. On the other hand, learned APP for the State opposed the bail application on the ground that accused/applicant was found in possession of 06 gram heroin. Thus he prayed for dismissal of the bail application.

5. After hearing both the sides and after going through the record, this Court finds that the present FIR has been registered against present accused/applicant Harpreet Kumar on the grounds that on 11.02.2026, the police party of P.S. Bhaini Mian Khan apprehended him on the basis of suspicion at turn of Nanowal Kalan. After complying with the provisions of Section 50 NDPS Act, his personal search was conducted and 06 gram heroin was found from one polythene pouch recovered from pocket of his pajama.

Accused/applicant was accordingly arrested. The recovery in this case is of 06 gram heroin which is just above small quantity. The fact of the said recovery is yet to be proved. Accused/applicant is in custody since 11.02.2026. No other criminal antecedents of the accused/applicant have been pointed out. Therefore, no purpose would be served by keeping the accused/applicant behind bars as presentation of challan and conclusion of trial is likely to take sufficient time. As such, present bail application is hereby allowed and accused/applicant is admitted to regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety of the like amount which may also be in the form of FDR, in the court of **learned Ilaqa/Duty Magistrate** to its own satisfaction, subject to following conditions:-

- i That he shall attend the court regularly;
- ii That he shall not hinder the ongoing investigation/trial;
- iii That he shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court;
- iv That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence;
- v. That he shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused or suspected.

The concerned Magistrate would send the requisite bonds after issuing the release warrants to this court immediately. However,

the observations made hereinabove shall have no effect on the merits of the main case. Police record be returned and record of the present bail application be attached with remand papers.
