1. The present miscellaneous application has been filed seeking two reliefs, one is for passing directions to the respondent no. 1 / State **to provide adequate compensation** and secondly, for passing order directing the respondent no. 1 **to provide adequate police protection to the applicant / complainant.**

2. After filing of the present miscellaneous application, the applicant / complainant filed one more application bearing **IA No. 2/2026 in MISC No. 513/2025 under section 14(3) SC/ST Act for day to day proceedings of the present complaint.** Immediately, thereafter, one more **application bearing IA No. 2/2026 in MISC CRL no. 513/2025** was filed for passing **directions to the respondent no. 2 / DCP, Outer North District to provide protection till the pendency of the present MISC CRL No. 513/2025.**

3. Notice to the above said application i.e. IA No. 2/2026 in MISC CRL no. 513/2025 has already been issued.

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4. Reply was filed by the IO stating that the complainant's allegations of receiving any threat or being pressurized to withdraw the FIR bearing No. 386/2024, does not find any support from any corner. It has been further stated that no CCTV footage and material evidence has been provided to him by the applicant.

5. On the other hand, it has been contended by the Ld. Counsel for the applicant that applicant went to Police station but he was harassed at police station. It is further argued by him that applicant had gone for providing CCTV footage to the IO, but it was not received by him. Though, IO SI Satish Kumar denies all the above said allegations levelled by the complainant and submitted that the applicant is adamant and does not cooperate in the investigation.

6. Arguments heard. Record perused.

7. ***Chapter IV A SC/ST Act provides the rights to the victim and witnesses which lays down provision for providing protection to the victim in need and witnesses to secure the ends of justice.***

8. Considering the photographs of the injury placed on record with the application i.e. IA No. 1/2026 in MISC CRL No. 513/2025, DCP, Outer North District is directed to provide the protection to the applicant till further orders. He is further directed to file report in this regard within a week.

9. Accordingly, the application i.e. IA No. 2/2026 in MISC CRL No. 513/2025 is hereby stands disposed of.

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10. Now coming to the application i.e. **IA No. 1/2026 in MISC CRL No. 513/2025**, in the said application, prayer has been made for day to day proceedings of the present complainant. As stated above, in the present complaint, the applicant has sought **two reliefs one is of compensation and other one is for protection.**

11. Regarding compensation, notice has already been issued to the DM concerned and it was reported by the applicant himself that he has handed over his bank account number to the IO as demanded by the IO in response to the notice of the application. Let notice be issued to the DM concerned to file report regarding compensation to the applicant / complainant. Secondly, with respect to the relief of protection, the application No. **IA No. 2/2026 in MISC CRL No. 513/2025** has already been disposed of. Therefore, as such there is no requirement of day to day proceedings in the present application. Accordingly, the application i.e. **IA No. 1/2026 in MISC CRL No. 513/2025** is disposed of accordingly.
