ORDER:

Present order of mine shall dispose off bail application filed
by applicant -Deepa Singh actual name Sandeep Singh.

2. Brief facts of the bail application are that the present case has
been registered against the applicant/accused is false, fabricated and based
upon totally false facts. It has been further stated that no offence as
alleged in the present FIR is committed by the applicant/accused and his
name has been given in the FIR to rope the whole family in the case.
Hence, it is prayed that applicant be admitted to bail.

3. Upon notice, learned Addl.PP for State appeared and
contested the bail application.

4. I have heard learned counsel for applicant, learned Addl.PP
for State and have gone through the records of the case file carefully.

5. The present FIR was registered at the instance of Excise
Inspector Harmeet Singh on the allegations that on 12.01.2022 he
alongwith police officials was present in the area of police station Sadar
Fazilka, that there he received a secret information and consequent upon

the same, he conducted raid in the area of hamlet Partap Singh, Mahatam Nagar at the house of non applicant Pala Singh. On seeing the police party, son of Pala Singh i.e., Harjinder Singh ran away from the spot, but he was apprehended with the help of other police officials. Thereafter, Harjinder Singh raised hue and cry and on hearing this, non applicant Pala Singh alongwith other non-applicants reached the spot, who were armed with dandas and sotas. Non applicant Ramesh Singh raised lalkara that complainant be caught hold of. Thereafter, non applicant Pala Singh gave blow of axe from the back side on the right thigh of C. Arvind Kumar, Harbhajan Singh gave blow of danda on chin of Arvind Kumar, applicant Deepa Singh gave blow of danda on the back of chest of HC Pardeep and the remaining accused started scuffling with the police party and managed to forcibly take Harjinder Singh out of custody of police party. Hence the present FIR.

6. After going through the allegations levelled in the FIR, it becomes apparent that applicant Deepa Singh @ Sandeep Singh is alleged to have caused blow of danda on the back of HC Pardeep Singh and the remaining accused scuffled with the police party and thereafter, managed to forcibly take Harjinder Singh out of custody of police party. They have deterred the police officials from discharging their official duties and have also assaulted them. The custodial interrogation of the applicant is necessary for recovery of weapon of offence. If the applicant is admitted to anticipatory bail, there is every likelihood that he will hamper the process of investigation. Keeping in view the aforesaid allegations, I am not inclined to allow the present anticipatory bail application. The same is found to be devoid of any merit and is hereby dismissed. File be consigned to the record room.
