ORDER:

1. Heard. The anticipatory bail application under Section 438 of Cr.P.C has been filed by the accused / applicant Ruby wife of Ajay, resident of Village Chhanni, Damtal, District Kangra (H.P) in case FIR No.04 dated 24.01.2022, under Section 21-29-61-85 of Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act registered at Police Station Nangal Bhoor.

2. Vide order dated 18.02.2022, the applicant/accused was granted ad-interim bail and he was directed to join investigation within seven days before Investigating Officer/SHO of Police Station Nangal Bhoor. It was ordered that in the event of her arrest, the Arresting Officer shall release her on interim bail to his satisfaction. The applicant shall abide by all the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

3. Today i.e. on 02.03.2022 Investigating Officer ASI Naresh Kumar No.1236/Ptk Posted at Police Station Nangal Bhoor has come present and suffered statement that the applicant / accused Ruby has joined investigation on 23.02.2022. The applicant/accused is not required for any interrogation in this case. Accordingly, in such view of the matter, it would be appropriate to finalize the ad-interim anticipatory bail which has been already granted by this Court vide order dated 18.02.2022. Accordingly, the ad-interim bail already granted to the applicant/accused is made absolute, subject to the condition that the applicant/accused shall continue appearing in the Trial Court. Any failure to comply with the condition as

envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C would entail this order to abate and this bail application under Section 438 of Cr.P.C is disposed off accordingly. Bail application file be consigned to the Record Room.
