

Jasbir Singh Vs. State of Punjab BA 2504-2019

Police record produced by ASI Baldev Singh. As per allegations contained in the FIR, on 03.04.2019, at about 5:00 p.m, in the area of Mobile Tower Railway Road, Dinanagar, 250 intoxicating tablets were allegedly recovered from accused Vishal. During interrogation, above accused disclosed to the I.O. that he has purchased above tablets from Jasbir Singh (petitioner). On the basis of above disclosure statement, present petitioner was nominated in this FIR. Apprehending his arrest, he filed present bail application.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that apart from alleged disclosure statement of co-accused, there is no incriminating material against the petitioner with the investigating agency. The petitioner is ready to join investigation and to cooperate in the same, so till the disposal of present bail application, he may be admitted to interim bail.

4. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, petitioner is directed to join investigation on **07.05.2019** at 10:00 AM. In the event of his arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail by the I.O. on his furnishing bonds in the sum of ₹ 30,000/- with one surety in the like

amount and subject to the fulfillment of the provisions of Section 438 (2)

Cr.P.C. Now police record be produced on **09.05.2019** for arguments.
