ORDER

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1. This order of mine shall dispose of two bail applications, one filed by Satvir Kaur & Jasvir Singh (BA no. 1099 of 2019) and other filed by Babu Singh (BA no.1121 of 2019), both under section 438 Cr.P.C seeking pre-arrest bail in case FIR no.67 dated 30.08.2019 under sections 323, 341, 328 read with section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at police station Mehal Kalan.
2. Record of police/investigating agency received and perused.
3. Heard on both the applications.
4. The instant case has been registered on the basis of statement of Manpreet Singh, husband of Satvir Kaur applicant-accused according to which he was married to Satvir Kaur about 5 years back. On 28.08.2019 at about 10.00 am he was away to his cattle house and in his absence his wife Satvir Kaur quarreled with his mother and sister Kirandeep Kaur and caused them beating. On coming to know of this incident he returned home and then Satvir Kaur forcibly taking mobile phone from him, rang up to her brother Jasvir Singh (applicant) who along with his maternal uncles Nirmal Singh, Mohinder Singh and maternal grand father Babu Singh (applicant) came to the house of complaint and abused him and caused him beating. Satvir Kaur forcibly administered him the insecticide lying in the house. He fell unconscious. Neighbourers gathered and he was taken to hospital.
5. The perusal of the MLR of Harpal Kaur mother of

complainant shows that three injuries were found on her person while³ as per MLR of Kirandeep Kaur sister of complainant one injury was found on her person. The bed head ticket of Manpreet Singh complainant of Community Health Centre Mehal Kalan and another hospital namely Simrat Hospital, shows that it was a suspected case of poisoning. The police during investigation has taken into possession one vial of insecticide. The applicants are none else than the wife, brother in law of the complainant. If there was any family dispute it was incumbent upon the in-law family of complainant to resolve the dispute but not to take the law into their own hand. The allegations against the applicants are very serious. Their custodial interrogation is necessary to know the exact sequence of events. Therefore, seeing the gravity of the allegations and number of injuries caused and the mode of injuries no ground is made out to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the applicants namely Satvir Kaur, Jasvir Singh and Babu Singh. Therefore, finding no merit in both the bail applications, the same are hereby dismissed accordingly. This order shall form part of file no.1099 and its copy be placed on the file no.1121. Files of bail applications be consigned to the record room.
