ORDER

Bail application put up before me being Duty
 Judge/Additional Sessions Judge.

2. This order of mine shall dispose of an application U/s 439
 Cr.P.C., for grant of bail filed by applicant.

2 Upon notice, Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor assisted by the
 investigating officer has appeared to represent the State and to contest the
 bail application.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned
 Addl. PP for the State and have gone through the record carefully.

4. It is the case of complainant Navdeep Kaur that she is
 doing Bsc Nursing. On 6.4.2018, at about 9.30 p.m while she was present
 in her hostel room, bail applicant Balbir Singh armed with 12 bore rifle
 came inside the room and started doing obscene acts with her. When she
 objected to the same, in a fit of rage with an intention to kill her, he fired
 a shot at her with his 12 bore rifle and which shot hit on the right side of
 her face.

5. Clearly, the offence in question is of serious nature and which does not call for the grant of interim bail to the applicant. It is noteworthy that previously also an application u/s 439 Cr.P.C had been filed by the bail applicant and which stood dismissed by this court vide order dated 4.9.2018, In the said circumstances and keeping in view the heinousness of the offence involved, the bail application in hand stands dismissed.
