ORDER:

1. Heard on the application for grant of regular bail to the applicant/accused in the above FIR.
2. Notice of the application was given to the State and Mrs. Taranvir Kaur Addl.P.P is present to represent the State.
3. As per the prosecution allegations, on 28.8.2017, recovery of 20 gm intoxicated powder was effected from the applicant/accused and she was granted interim bail and her bail application was adjourned for awaiting report of Chemical Examiner which has now been received. According to the said report, the sample contains intoxicant i.e. Diphenoxylate hydrochloride, which does not fall under commercial quantity.
4. The trial of the case is likely to take considerable time . No useful purpose will be served by sending her behind the bars again.
5. **Keeping in view the gravity of offences and the fact that applicant is appearing regularly since the grant of interim bail, the said bail granted to him vide order dated 24.10.2017 is hereby made absolute.**
