An application was moved by the claimant for getting her examined as to disability. She claims that disability occurred owing to the accident on **09.06.2024**. The application is accompanied by the format prescribed in Form J (Under Rule 18 of Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Delhi).

As per Order No. F No. 24/Misc.Policy/Disability/DHS/NHS/1039-45 Dated 02/05/2019 issued by the Department of Health & Family Welfare 'Aruna Asaf Ali Hospital' is earmarked for Central District for the purposes of assessment of disability. As per observations made by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in ***Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Company Ltd. Vs Union of India in Writ Petition (s) (Civil) No (s). 534/2020*** date of order 16/11/2021, the District Medical Board has been directed to follow the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India vide Gazette Notification S. No. 61, dated 05.01.2018 for issuance of disability Certificate.

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Accordingly, in terms of the above, the 'Medical Superintendent', Aruna Asaf Ali Hospital, Delhi is directed to get the petitioner examined by a Medical Board for the purpose of ascertaining Orthopedic / permanent disability, if any, and the extent of disability. The petitioner is directed to appear before the office of M.S. Aruna Asaf Ali Hospital, Delhi within 15 days.

The M.S. / Medical Board shall be at liberty to fix any other date convenient to them for the medical examination of the petitioner and send the report/disability certificate directly to this Tribunal within 15 days alongwith an attested copy of the records of medical examination carried out for the purpose of assessment of disability. A copy of the same be also provided to the petitioner.

Copy of this order alongwith original 'Form J' bearing photograph of claimant and copy of **discharge summary/MLC** be sent to the MS concerned.

Since the matter pertains to Senior Citizen, the concerned M.S. is also directed to expedite the assessment of disability and file the report at the earliest.

Dasti be given.

Put up on **24.09.2025** for report of disability as well as filing of WS.
