ORDER

1. The applicant has filed this application for the grant of regular bail to him in a criminal case having FIR no. 19 dated 22.12.2020 under sections 489-A/489-B/489-C IPC, P.S. City Khanna, Distt. Ludhiana.

2. I have heard Ld. counsel for the applicant, Ld. Addl.P.P. for the State and gone through the police record.

3. Ld. Counsel for the applicant has submitted that the police has registered a false case against the accused. Nothing was recovered from him. He is in judicial custody and no more required for further

investigation. Conclusion of trial will take sufficient time and prayed that applicant be admitted to bail.

4. On the other hand, Ld. Addl.P.P. for State has opposed the bail application and prayed that bail application of applicant be dismissed.

5. After hearing Ld. Counsel for the applicant and Ld. Addl.P.P. for State, I am of the view that as per prosecution case, the accused was arrested by ASI Mashinder Singh on the basis of secret information and 12 counterfeit currency notes of Rs. 500/- each were recovered from him. Applicant Deepak was arrested on 22.1.2020 and now he is in judicial custody. Recovery if any has already been effected. Nothing more is to be recovered from him. Presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take sufficient time. As such, applicant Deepak is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.50000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Ld. Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, Khanna. The applicant is directed not leave the country without prior permission of the court. The applicant is also directed not to pressurise the prosecution witnesses in any manner. This order of mine shall have no effect on the merits of case. Police record be returned and this file be consigned to the record room.
