Application for bail u/s 438 Cr.P.C

ORDER

Applicant/accused Randhir Kaur has moved an application for concession of anticipatory bail in complaint under Section 138 NIA. This is the second anticipatory bail application filed by her. It is submitted she has compromised the matter with complainant and as per compromise complainant had already received an amount of Rs.2.35 lac and remaining amount will be paid to complainant on his appearance in the Court. Hence, the bail application.

2. Notice of the said application was given to the respondent. Sh. Ravi Sareen Addl. PP appeared on behalf of State/respondent no.1 and Sh. RS Dyal Adv., appeared on behalf of respondent no.2 and opposed the bail application.

3. Heard. Trial Court record requisitioned and perused.

4. The complaint under Section 138 NIA was filed by Vijay Rana against Randhir Kaur. However, a compromise has been effected between the parties and complainant Vijay Rana has suffered a statement before the Court that he has received the

remaining payment of Rs.40,000/- from the accused Randhir Kaur regarding the cheque in question bearing no.026484 dated 14.11.2012 and he has no objection in case the applicant/accused is granted concession of bail.

5. In view of the statement suffered by the complainant, the application for anticipatory bail stands allowed. The applicant is directed to appear before the trial Court and move bail application within a period of 10 days from the date of order and Trial Court shall admit her on bail provided she is ready to furnish bail bonds and surety bonds as per the directions of the Trial Court. Trial Court record along with copy of this order be sent to the concerned Court for necessary information and compliance and bail application file be consigned to record room.
