ORDER:

This order of mine will dispose of an application for regular
bail moved by accused / applicant Jaspreet Singh in case FIR No.68 dated
29.05.2018, Under Section: 306 IPC, Police Station: Sadar Mansa.

2. Perusal of the investigation record reveals the fact that case
was registered on the basis of statement suffered by complainant Ranjit
Singh. Wherein he alleged that his sister Harshdeep Kaur has committed

suicide due to harassment caused by her husband Jaspreet Singh, Shamsher Singh and Palwinder Singh.

3. Ld. Counsel for accused / applicant pressed for grant of bail on the ground that accused / applicant has been falsely implicated in this case. Accused / applicant is in custody since 11.06.2018. Conclusion of trial will take considerable time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused / applicant in custody.

4. On the other hand, ld. Addl. PP has refuted above contentions on the ground that accused / applicant has committed heinous offence. Ld. Addl. PP has further contended that in case accused is allowed regular bail he will tamper with the prosecution evidence. Prayer for dismissal of the bail application has been made.

5. Accused/ applicant has been arrested on 11.06.2018 and since then he is in judicial custody. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused/ applicant in custody for indefinite period. Conclusion of trial will take considerable time.

6. In the light of aforesaid reasons, taking into consideration the totality of the facts and circumstances, the present bail application is allowed. Accused/ applicant Jaspreet Singh is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of ld. Ilaqa Magistrate/duty Magistrate, Mansa and subject to following conditions:

- i) that the applicant shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required.

- ii) that the applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusations against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer.
- iii) that the applicant shall not leave India without the previous due permission of the court.

Copy of this order be sent to the Court of Id. Ilaqa Magistrate, Mansa forthwith. Record be returned and record of bail application be consigned to record room after due compilation.
