ORDER:

1. Judicial Record perused.

It is evident from the judicial record that **Ranjit Singh @ Kala (bail applicant)** absented from the Court on **20.04.2022** without intimation to the Court, therefore, bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited to the State. The **bail applicant** was ordered to be summoned through **non-ailable warrants** for **24.08.2022** and ultimately, **bail applicant** was declared as **proclaimed offender** vide order dated **28.02.2024**. Now. Bail applicant has **surrendered** himself in the Court on **04.03.2024** and since then he is in custody. In the bail application it is averred that the bail application could not appear in the Court due to some health issues. Although, there is nothing in the shape of medical record to say that bail applicant was suffering from any ill health, on the date fixed, yet observing that **bail applicant** has **been surrendered himself** in the Court on 04.03.2024 and he has **suffered sufficient penalty** for his absence from the Court. Therefore, I deem it proper to admit **bail applicant** on bail, as conclusion of trial is going to take time. Therefore, bail application stands **allowed**. The **bail applicant** is ordered to be **admitted to bail** on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of **Rs. One Lakh** with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of **Illaqa/Duty Magistrate**. However, proceedings under Section **446 of the Cr. P.C.** shall remain continue. **Copy of order be placed with main file.**
