Gurdeep Singh alias Gaggu aged about 35 years, son of Jarnail Singh, resident of village near saunikavad, Nangal Kalan District Mansa, now confined at District Jail, Mansa.

Bail application under Section 483 BNSS.

ORDER

The present regular bail application has been filed by accused/ applicant Gurdeep Singh alias Gaggu under the provisions of Section 483 BNSS, in FIR No.73 dated 01.06.2025 under Section 21 29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station, City-1, Mansa.

2. Notice of the bail application has been issued to the State. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State has appeared. Police record has been produced.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that applicant/accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. Further submits that this is second regular bail application as the first bail application has been dismissed as withdrawn on 02.07.2025. Further submits that applicant/accused is totally innocent and falsely implicated. Nothing intoxicant substance has been got recovered from the possession of the applicant/accused. Further submits that applicant/accused has been arrayed as an accused merely on the basis of the alleged version of co-accused. Further submits that applicant/accused was behind the bars in some other case when he has been nominated and later arrested in the present case. No recovery has been effected from the applicant/accused and he is behind the bars since 10.06.2025 thus, prays that present bail application may kindly be allowed.

4. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State submits that in the present case, FIR has been registered against accused Kuldeep Singh and Gurpreet Singh as the said accused persons were apprehended by the police and 1.15 gms of Heroin has been got recovered from the polythene lying in their possession. Further submits that applicant/accused has been nominated in the present case as an accused on the alleged version of accused Jaspal Singh, from whom 11.80 gms of Heroin along with ₹12,000/- drug money has been got recovered. The said accused has been nominated on the statement of the other co-accused. Further submits that accused/applicant has been arrested in the present case while in

custody in some other case and no intoxicant substance has been got recovered from his possession. Further submits that there is only one FIR under NDPS Act registered against present accused/applicant and the other FIRs are under IPC. Further submits that accused/applicant has committed serious offense and thus, prays that present bail application may kindly be dismissed.

5. After hearing learned counsel for applicant and learned Additional P.P for the State and perusal of the record, it reflects that in the present case, at the first instance, accused Kuldeep Singh and Gurpreet Singh has been apprehended by the police and it is alleged that from the said accused persons only 1.15 gms of Heroin has been got recovered and thereafter, accused Gursewak Singh has been arrayed as an accused on 01.06.2025 vide DDR No.5 and has been arrested on 02.06.2025 and accused Jaspal Singh has been arrayed as an accused on 02.06.2025 and has been arrested on 03.06.2025 and from said accused 11.80 gms of Heroin has been recovered along with ₹12,000/- drug money. Further accused Ramandeep Singh and Rohit Kumar have been arrayed as accused vide rapat No.41 dated 03.06.2025. Applicant/accused has been arrayed as an accused vide rapat No.43 dated 03.06.2025. Further, it is the admitted fact by the prosecution that present accused/applicant has been arrested in the present case on production warrants while he was in custody in FIR No.123 dated 25.05.2025, under Section 21 of NDPS Act, Police Station, Sadar Mansa. It is the fact that accused/applicant has been

nominated under Section 29 of the NDPS Act and nothing intoxicant has been got recovered from his possession. To the other FIR under NDPS Act, it is pertinent to mention that the accused/applicant is arrested while he was in custody in the said FIR No.123 dated 25.05.2025, Police Station Sadar Mansa. It is the fact that accused/applicant is behind the bars since 10.06.2025 and nothing intoxicant has been got recovered from the present accused/accused. No fruitful purpose would be served by further detaining the accused/applicant behind the bars and it is the matter of the trial to be seen at the time of trial regarding the connection of the present accused/applicant with the other accused persons and the recovery. So, without commenting anything on the final merits of the case, present bail application is allowed and accused/applicant is admitted to bail, subject to furnishing of bail bond in the sum of ₹ 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount before the Ld. Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate and further subject to the condition that applicant/accused will neither leave the country without prior permission of the court, nor applicant/accused will tamper with the evidence nor will put pressure on the witnesses of the prosecution and will appear on each and every date of hearing of the Court. Record of present bail application be attached with the remand papers.
