

**Court of ADJ-I, JAMUI****BA No. 1007/2022****(Arising out of Chakai P.S Case no. 269/2022)**Under Sections 363/366(A)/120(B)/34 of IPC

**07.01.2023** By way of this order, this court is going to dispose the regular bail petition, filed on behalf of accused **Dipak Kumar Ram, S/o- Gautam Ram.**

Ld. counsel for accused submitted that accused has falsely been implicated in this case and the allegation against the accused is false and baseless. It is further submitted that the accused is in judicial custody since 07.11.2021.

On the other hand, ld. APP strongly opposed the bail petition.

In brief prosecution story is on dated 02.11.2022 at about 3.00 AM when the informant woke up his daughter, victim herein, aged about 14 years is missing from her room. He tried to find out her daughter, but she could not be traced. He further stated that since last days Sonu Kumar was wandering around his house. The informant also informed the father of Sonu Kumar about his conduct and the informant has expressed apprehension that her daughter has kidnapped by Sonu Singh, Somnath Singh, Arun Singh and the wife of Arun Singh, Abhishek Kumar Ram and Dipak Kumar Ram, who has also abated the accused for the commission of the crime.

Argument heard from both sides and record perused. Admittedly this accused is in judicial custody since 07.11.2022. On going through the case diary in para number 59, it transpires that there is a love affair between victim and accused Sonu Singh and there is no specific role played by this accused for the kidnapping of the victim girl only the father of the victim expressed apprehension against this accused. Taking into the consideration the period of incarceration and all the facts and circumstances of the case, the bail petition of the accused/petitioner namely **Dipak Kumar Ram**, is allowed subject to furnishing bail bond of amount Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, with condition that, one of the bailor must be the family members of the petitioner.
