ORDER

1. This application for regular bail has been moved on behalf of applicant/accused Sahil for offences under Sections 21-B, 27-A and 29 of NDPS Act, by virtue of Section 483 BNSS.

2 Notice of bail application was given to State. Police record has been received and perused. Arguments have been heard

3 As per case of prosecution, on 17.06.2026, in the area of PS Sadar, accused Sahil was apprehended and on his search recovery of 06 grams heroin and Rs.200/-, alleged to be drug money, was effected.

During investigation, Sofia was nominated as accused in the present case on the basis of disclosure statement of accused Sahil.

4. It may be submitted at the very outset that the alleged recovery is that of 06 grams of heroin as well as Rs.200/- from possession of applicant/accused Sahil. On the face of it, such recovery of intoxicant comes within the preview of non-commercial quantity, although report of FSL is yet to receive. At this stage, there is also nothing on record from which it could be inferred that present applicant/accused financing the illicit traffic and harbouring any offender. The applicability of Section 27-A of NDPS Act in the present case is a matter of evidence and criminal liability of accused shall be determined during the trial of the case. Applicant/accused has been in custody since long. Therefore, in the interest of justice, applicant/accused Sahil is admitted to interim bail till the receipt of report of FSL, subject to his furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Id. Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, subject to following conditions:-

1. That applicant will appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing during trial without fail;
2. That applicant will not leave the Country without prior permission of the Court;
3. That applicant will not induce the prosecution witnesses as well as will not tamper the prosecution evidence, in any manner.

It is made clear that this order shall be subject to modification on receipt of report of FSL.

5. Ahlmad is directed to send a soft a soft copy of this bail order through official e-mail to the concerned Jail Superintendent for the purpose of conveying the same to the concerned accused as directed vide order dated 31.01.2023 passed by the **Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Suo Moto Writ Petition (Crl.) no.4 of 2021 Re.: Policy Strategy Grant of Bail.**

Police record be returned. Bail application file be consigned to the record room.
