It is submitted by Ld. counsel for plaintiff that the names of defendants no. 2 to 4 be deleted from the array of parties.

In view of the submissions made by Ld. counsel for plaintiff and in view of the judgment titled as "Sanjiv Kumar Mittal Vs. Deputy Commissioner (TRC), CGST Commissionerate Delhi South & Ors" passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, the names of defendants no. 2 to 4 are deleted from the array of parties. Let, amended memo of parties be filed.

Issue summons for settlement of issues against the defendant no. 1 only on filing of PF/RC, Speed Post, Courier, Whatsapp/email returnable for 22.09.2026. Dasti be also given. The plaintiff is also directed to file the affidavit of service on the defendant no. 1 and affidavit regarding having facility of Whatsapp/email on the mobile number of the defendant no. 1.

The summons to the defendant no. 1 shall indicate that the "defendant no. 1 should file WS within 30 days from the date of service/receipt of summons", with advance copy to the plaintiff.

The defendant no. 1 shall also file statement of truth, affidavit regarding admission/denial of the documents filed by the plaintiff in accordance with Order 11 Rule 4 CPC as amended by The Commercial Courts Act, 2015, alongwith the WS.

The plaintiff would be at liberty to file replication to the WS of the defendants no. 1 within 15 days of receipt of copy of WS, with advance copy of the replication to the defendant no. 1. Replication shall be accompanied by statement of admission/denial in respect of the

documents filed by the defendant no. 1. Process Server is directed to affix the process in case of refusal/ non availability/ premises found locked.
