Mediation could not succeed, due to non participation by the parties as told by counsels. Nevertheless, the matter may proceed and that brings application u/o VI Rule 17 CPC in picture, copy of which had already been provided to the plaintiff and reply is also filed on behalf of the plaintiff.

Before the arguments at the outset, counsel for the plaintiff stated that he has no objection to the application subject to the heavy cost, especially when the documents which are sought to be brought on record were in the custody and knowledge of the defendant and were in the knowledge of the defendant from day one.

As such, when their amendment is not opposed, the application u/o VI Rule 17 CPC stands allowed. The issue of the cost would be taken up at a later stage and the matter may otherwise proceed.
