

Accused is present. Sri. U.K. advocate has filed vakalath on behalf of the accused. He submits that he is willing to plead guilty for the offences alleged against him. The substance of accusation framed and the same is read over and explained to the accused and after understanding the same, the accused has pleaded guilty for the offences punishable U/s.4(1), 12(1), 6(a) 24(9a) of Karnataka Shops and commercial Act. The consequences of pleading guilty is explained to the accused. Thereafter also the accused submits that, he is going to plead guilty for the offences punishable U/s.4(1), 12(1), 6(a) 24(9a), 24(4), 8(1) of Karnataka Shops and commercial Act. The plea of accused is voluntary. Hence, the same is hereby accepted and I proceed to pass the following:

Acting U/s.264 of BNSS,the accused is hereby convicted,

- 1) For the offence punishable U/s.4(1) and sentenced to pay a fine of **Rs.500/-**, in default he shall undergo S.I. for 3 days.
- 2) For the offence punishable U/s.12(1) and sentenced to pay a fine of **Rs.500/-**, in default he shall undergo S.I. for 3 days.
- 3) .For the offence punishable U/s.6(A), r/w 24(9A)) and sentenced to pay a fine of **Rs.1,000/-**, in default he shall undergo S.I. for 3 days.
- 4) For the offence punishable U/s.24(4) and sentenced to pay a fine of **Rs. 500/-** in default he shall undergo S.I. for 3 days.
- 5) For the offence punishable U/s.8(1) and sentenced to pay a fine of **Rs.500/-** in default he shall undergo S.I. for 3 days.

Accused submits that he is ready to pay the fine amount. Office to take total amount of **Rs.3000/-**
