

Case is advanced to today.

Petitioner is present with her counsel. Sri. VRGP Advocate appearing for the respondent No.2/insurance company is also present.

Both the parties wish to compromise this case. Accordingly, they have filed Joint Memo, which bears the signatures of both the parties. The contents of joint memo is read over to the petitioner. She submits, that, she is aware of the contents of the same.

The Respondent No.2 agreed to pay a sum of **Rs.1,35,000/-** [One lakh thirty five thousand] only to the petitioner within two months towards full and final settlement. The petitioner agreed for the same. Accordingly, she has filed her sworn affidavit furnishing her bank details.

In view of the joint memo filed by the parties, they are permitted to compromise the case.

Accordingly, the Joint memo filed by the parties is accepted.

The respondent No.2 / Insurance company is directed to deposit the compensation amount directly to the account of the petitioner at Karnataka Bank, Mangalpady Branch, IFSC code KARB0000467 bearing A/C No. 4672500101512501 within two months and transmit the receipt of the same to the Court immediately.

Office to draw the award as per the Joint memo.

Accordingly, this case is closed as compromised.
