ORDER

The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners U/Sec.372 of the Indian Successions Act, seeking to issuance of succession certificate with respect to amount which is detailed in the schedule.

2. The brief facts of the petition is as under:

a). It is the case of the petitioners that, the petitioner No.1 is mother of Late Chandrashekar Ural and petitioner No.2 is wife of Late Chandrashekar Ural. Further they are contended that the said Chandrashekar Ural died on 26.09.2025 and they are only successor of said deceased Chandrashekar Ural for his all assets and liabilities. Further they are contended that during life time of the said Chandrashekar Ural working as a Assistant Specialist, Customer Support, Branch Office at Refinitiv India Shared Service Pvt. Ltd., at Yamalur Village, Varadhur Hobli, H.A.L. Airport, Bengaluru. Further he is having Provident Fund in the said Branch and he is the customer of State Bank of India, Bengaluru Branch and he is having Insurance Policy and he is having Saving Bank Account in Axis Bank, M.G. Road, Bengaluru.



b). Further they are contended that after death of said Chandrashekar Ural, they are demanded to issue the said amount, but the said bank and Provident Fund Office seeks Succession Certificate from the competent Court. Hence they constrain to file this petition.

3. In order to prove their case, petitioner No.1 examined herself as PW1 and 11 documents were marked as Ex.P1 to Ex.P11 and close their side.

4. Heard the arguments.

5. After perusal of the records of the case, the following points would arise for my consideration:

1. Whether petitioners are entitled for the reliefs as prayed in the petition?
2. What order ?
6. My finding on the above said points as under;

7. **Point No.1:-** PW1 deposed in her evidence affidavit, she has reiterated the petition averments and



produced 11 documents which are marked as Ex.P1 to Ex.P11. Ex.P1 is the Notarized copy of election Election identity card of petitioner No.1, Ex.P2 is the notarized copy of the ration card, Ex. P3 is the notarized copy of the Aadhaar card of petitioner No.1, Ex.P4 is the notarized copy of the Aadhaar card of petitioner No.2, Ex. P5 is the death certificate of Chandrashekar Ural, Ex. P6 is the attestation of family tree, Ex. P7 is the copy of the surviving family members certificate, Ex. P8 is the S.B.I. Life Insurance, Ex. P9 is the paper publication in Vijaya Karnataka News Paper wherein the contents of petition averments have been duly published, Ex. P10 is the pass book and Ex. P11 is the customer portfolio.

8. On perusal of entire materials available on record the relationship of the petitioners with deceased Chandrashekar Ural is not disputed. On 26.09.2025 Chandrashekar Ural died. Further during the life time of said Chandrashekar Ural was obtained Insurance Policy in State Bank of India, he is having provident fund in Refinitiv India Shared Service Pvt. Ltd., at Yamalur Village, Varadhur Hobli, H.A.L. Airport, Bengaluru and Saving Account in Axis Bank as per Ex. P8, P10 and P11. Further the petitioners are the legal heirs of deceased



Chandrashekar Ural the said fact discloses that as per Ex. P6 and P7. Further as per Ex. P9 the petitioners are taken paper publication in Vijaya Karnataka daily news Paper for appearance of any interested person and claim for seeking Provident Fund amount, Insurance claim and S.B. Bank account, but no one can objected before the court. Hence I am of the opinion that the petitioners are being the only successors to the deceased Chandrashekara Urla are entitled to claim amount laying in above said amount shown in the schedule. Hence, the petitioners are proved that they are entitled for obtaining succession certificate for the receipt of said amount. Hence, I inclined to hold above **Point No.1 in the Affirmative.**

9. **Point No.2:-** In view of my discussion made supra, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The petition filed by the petitioners U/Sec.372 of Indian Succession Act is hereby allowed.

The petitioners are entitled to succession certificate in respect of schedule properties in



the name of deceased Chandrashekar Ural entitled to claim amount mentioned in the schedule.

Issue Succession Certificate to the petitioners after collecting the court fee, accordingly.

No order as to costs.
