BA-110-2024 State of Punjab Versus Baljit Singh

1. Heard on the bail application filed by accused **Baljit Singh** through his counsel and supported by the affidavit of **Manjit Singh**, who is brother of the applicant/accused. It is contended in the application that the applicant is innocent and has not committed any crime. Asserting on these grounds the concession of bail has been requested.

2. Notice of the application was given to the Ld. APP for the State who has not filed the written reply but has vehemently opposed this application on the ground that the allegations against the accused are serious in nature.

3. The FIR has been against the accused for the offence punishable under Section 221, 132 BNS on the allegations that complainant controlling the traffic alongwith his colleagues then accused was coming towards the Goindwal Sahib from the Market side in an inebriated state, stumbling and shouting. Accused started abusing the complainant and grabbed the collar, tearing the buttons of uniform of the complainant.

4. The allegations against the accused are serious in nature. The investigation is at initial stage. As such, this court finds no justification in the granting of bail as there is every possibility that the accused may misuse the concession of the bail. In view of the gravity of the nature of offence, the

court is of the opinion that the accused do not deserve the Concession of Bail. Accordingly, the bail application stands dismissed. Bail application be attached with the case file.
