Case called before the Lok-Adalath.

Petitioner No.1 to 4 are present with their counsels and Sri.KRA counsel appearing for the respondent No. 3 is present.

Both the parties wish to compromise this case. Accordingly, they have filed Joint Memo. The contents of the joint memo are read over to the petitioners. They submit that, they are aware of the contents of the same.

The respondent No.2 agreed to pay a sum of **Rs.8,00,000/-**[Eight lakhs] only to the petitioners within two months towards full and final settlement. The petitioners agreed for the same.

In view of the Joint memo filed by the parties, they are permitted to compromise this case.

The petitioner are entitled to the

compensation amount at the ratio of 15:15:15:55. The respondent No.3 is directed to deposit the compensation amount directly to the accounts of the petitioner No.1 at Karnataka Gramina Bank, Koyanadu Branch, IFSC code PKGB0012251 bearing A/C No. 12251100001424, petitioner No.2 at Canara Bank, Murnad Branch, IFSC code CNRD0011104, bearing A/c No. 11042200067210, petitioner No.3 at SBI, Kushalnagar Branch, IFSC SBIN0040388, bearing A/C No. 64071535562 and petitioner No.4 at Karnataka Gramina Bank, Koynadu branch, Madikeri Taluk IFSC code PKGB0012251, bearing A/c No. 12251100001442 within two months and transmit the receipt of the same to the Court immediately.

Accordingly, the Joint memo is accepted.
