

**ORDER ON APPLICATION FILED UNDER
ORDER VII RULE 14(3) AND SECTION
151 OF CPC**

The learned counsel appearing for plaintiff has filed an application under Order VII Rule 14(3) and Section 151 of CPC, praying to produce the Section 65B certificate.

Per contra, the learned counsel appearing for defendant filed his objection and submitted that the said application is not maintainable. Further the document sought to be produced is irrelevant and same is not necessary for the adjudication of the present suit and therefore prays to dismiss the same.

Heard.

After perusal of the materials available on record the Plaintiff is intending to produce Section 65B certificate for the photographs which were earlier produced. Since it is the right of the plaintiff to produce the certificate at any stage of the proceedings, no prejudice will be caused to whomsoever more particularly to the defendant if the said application is allowed. Further, in order to ascertain the true facts of the present case, the photographs which were produced is very much necessary and to prove its genuineness, the certificate sought to be produced plays a vital role. Hence, in order to avoid multiplicity of the proceedings, this Court proceeds to pass the following;

ORDER

The application file under Order VII Rule 14(3) and Section 151 of CPC is hereby **allowed**.
