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Application for releasing the accused/applicant on bail till decision
of the case.

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Present:- Mr.Suneet Kumar, Learned APP for the State.
Mr.Sambhav Jain, Advocate for accused/applicants
Madan Lal and Manjit Singh.

1. Record produced and perused. Heard on bail application filed on
behalf of applicants/accused.

2. Learned counsel for applicant-accused averred that the false case
have been registered against the accuseds/applicant and they have not
committed any offences as alleged in the FIR. The applicants-accused are in
judicial custody since 28.01.2026. The trial of the case will take long time and
no useful purpose will be served by keeping the applicants-accused behind bars.
Hence, the present bail application.

3. On the other hand, learned APP for the State has argued that the
offences are serious in nature. He prayed that the bail application of
applicants/accused may kindly be dismissed.

4. Heard. Perusal of the file reveals that the applicants-accused are in
custody since 27.01.2026. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the
applicants-accused in custody for an indefinite period. As such, applicants-
accused in question are ordered to be released on bail on furnishing personal
bond in the sum of ₹ 40,000/- each with one surety in the like amount.

5. Bail bonds and surety bonds furnished not furnished. Bail
application be attached with the challan/FIR/remand papers.
