

**ORDER ON I.A.NO.1 FILED BY THE
PETITIONERS UNDER SECTION
144(2) OF BNSS 2023.**

The petitioner has filed an application U/sec.144(2) of B.N.S.S 2023 for seeking interim maintenance of Rs.15,000/- per month to the petitioner from the respondent.

2. Heard the arguments on IA No.1 by the counsel for petitioner Kum.K.R.P.

3. In the I.A.No.1. it is stated by the petitioner that, the marriage between the

petitioner and respondent is solemnized on 01-10-2015 at "Sri. Keshava Veda and Kala Prathishtana (Reg.), Sullia " as per the customs prevailing in the community in the presence of well wishers of both the parties. Further it is stated in the application that, the respondent is well educated person and he is working in private company and earning more than Rs.30,000/- per month and he is having sufficient source of income. The respondent had valuable land property. After the marriage the respondent started to drinking the Alcohol and giving physical and mental ill treatment to petitioner. The respondent stated treating the petitioner with cruelty. The respondent never money rendered any financial help to the petitioner and petitioner having no source of income. Petitioner for her day to day bear minimum requirements for food, clothing, shelter, medicine etc., and need of Rs.500/- per day for day to day requirements. Hence, prayed to direct the respondent to pay the maintenance amount of Rs.15,000/- per month.

4. Further, The petitioner has produced the certificate issued by Sri Keshava Kripa

Veda and Kala Prathishtana Sullia (Reg.) dated 01-10-2017 pertaining to marriage of petitioner and respondent, Marriage photo of petitioner and respondent, acknowledgment issued by A.S.I. Sullia dated 12-07-2025, complaint copy dated 09-01-2024 by petitioner against the respondent before the Sullia P.S. It is worth to note that, it is the duty of the respondent, who is the husband of the petitioner. At the same time, the respondent being the husband is liable to provide for the basic necessities of his wife. On the grounds made by the petitioner, the petitioner is in need of money for their basic needs. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The respondent is hereby directed to pay maintenance of Rs.2,500/- per month to petitioner.
