

Ram Murti Vs. State of Punjab
(FIR No. 07 of 2022, City Rajpura)

Present : Sh. Jitender Singh, APP for the State.
Ms. Sushma Singla, Advocate for applicant/ accused Ram Murti.

1. The present order shall dispose off the bail application filed by the applicant/ accused Ram Murti through counsel for allegedly committing the offence punishable under Section 6, 23, PC, PNDT Act.

2. Ld. Counsel for the applicant/ accused submitted that the applicant/ accused has been falsely implicated in the present case and he has not committed any such offence. Ld. Counsel further submitted that no recovery is to be effected from the applicant/ accused. Hence, a prayer for releasing the accused / applicant on bail has been made.

3. On the other hand, learned Addl.P.P for the State filed reply to the bail application by denying the averments. Ld. APP for the State further submitted that accused/ applicant has committed serious offence and he is not entitled for concession of bail and prayed for the dismissal of the bail application.

4. I have heard Ld. Counsel for the applicant/ accused and Ld. APP for the State and have gone through the record carefully.

5. In precise the story of prosecution is that applicant/ accused along with co-accused Krishan Gopal was indulged in Sex Determination Test. A raid was conducted by the team of Health Department, Haryana at the Government Quarters of A.P. Jain Civil Hospital, Rajpura and accused were apprehended. On the aforesaid allegations, FIR was registered against

accused persons. The allegations levelled against the applicant/ accused are yet to be proved. The applicant/ accused is in judicial custody since 10.01.2022. The alleged recovery has already been effected and nothing is to be recovered from the applicant/ accused. The presentation of challan and thereafter, conclusion of trial would take a long time and no useful purpose will be served by keeping the applicant/ accused in custody for indefinite period. Thus, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, the applicant/ accused namely Ram Murti is admitted to bail in the present case under Section 6, 23 Pre Conception and Pre Natal Diagnostic Techniques Act, 1994, on his furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety of the like amount, subject to following conditions:-

- 1) The applicant shall appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing.
- 2) The applicant shall not interfere in the investigation or indulge himself in influencing or threatening the witnesses.
- 3) The applicant shall not leave the territory of India without the prior permission of the Court.

Requisite Bail bonds/ surety bonds not furnished.
